You have five (5) days from receipt of a pen to return it for any reason. All pens are restored unless specifically noted in the description. **Postage & Insurance are additional.** All pens are shipped insured. For shipments in the US we prefer USPS, and outside the US we prefer Express Mail International. We will of course use other shippers at customer request.

Generally, our pens are warranted for 90 days. Unfortunately, we sometimes cannot restore some modern pens (post-1970) due to lack of parts or inaccessibility to the mechanisms (many modern pen companies manufacture their pens with the plan that no restoration will ever be done). 1	Colorado	1945	Double-barreled, double nibbed PIF in Red Laminated with "scissor" barrel configuration. NPT. Red dot & white dot on gripping sections so you know which side has which color ink. Incredible pen, almost never found in this condition. Shown open. The scissor "swivel" allows the user to fill each of the two reservoirs separately. Medium nibs. Near mint. Shown open.	\$6500
2	Colorado	1945	Double-barreled, double nibbed PIF in Black with "scissor" barrel configuration. NPT. Red dot & white dot on gripping sections so you know which side has which color ink. Incredible pen, almost never found in this condition. Shown open. The scissor "swivel" allows the user to fill each of the two reservoirs separately. Medium nibs. Near mint. Shown open.	\$2000
3	La Plume D'Or	1924	Bibax capillary-fill Taper/Cone Cap in Red Mottled Hard Rubber. Extremely rare. Information found in <i>"Une Affaire de Stylos" Quintette</i> (1990) [in French language only]. Barrel imprint "Le Bibax B.S.G.D.G. Unis France." "B.S.G.D.G." is the abbreviation for "Brevet Sans Garantie du Gouvernement" which means "Patented without State Guarantee." While the barrel is a hollow hard rubber tube, it is NOT an eyedropper-fill. There are four long slots in the back of the feed. The filling design is to put the pen, nib down, into an ink supply, and the barrel fills through the principle of liquid settling to its own level. Correct nib (medium) signed "D & D Paris 18 cts 3." "D & D" stands for "Demely & Degan," the founders of La Plume D'Or. New-old-stock. Mint in original box (one end flap missing from box cover).	\$650
4	Montblanc/ Diplomat	1912	#1 LF in RMHR. Rare, both in size, color & filling system. One of the most famous and desirable of the Montblanc sub-brands, manufactured from 1912 through around 1928. Produced with both a "Warranted" nib and a recognizable Montblanc nib, this example has the latter, more desirable nib (fine). No signs of use. Very crisp barrel imprint. Some wear to the nickel plating on the lever, otherwise near mint.	\$1600
5	Montblanc	1946	136 Meisterstück PIF in Black. Rare model with long Visualated window, with perfect pinstripping. What's even rarer is the medium, extra-flexible nib! A double whammy! GFT. Near mint+ (maybe new-old-stock).	\$1500
6	Montblanc	1943	139 Meisterstück PIF in Black. Visualated window, still with perfect pinstripping. GFT. Celluloid cap with outer cap bands in sterling silver. This pen was the model for the limited edition Hemingway. Fine nib. NEW-OLD-STOCK. MINT IN ORIGINAL BOX with papers. You'll never find a nicer example!	\$4300
7	Montegrappa	1920	#4 Elmo Safety eyedropper-fill in Red Hard Rubber. Elmo is a Montegrappa subbrand. Signed "Elmo 14K 4" nib (fine, extra-flexible). A small mark or two in the barrel knurling & a small dark band near the top of the cap where a label must have been. Nr mint+ with deep barrel imprint & no signs of ink. In original box.	\$1600





8	Parker	1905	Model 42 1/2 eyedropper-fill in Black Chased Hard Rubber with gold-filled "Chased" repousse cap top and 3/4" "Floral & Chased" repousse cap band. Parker Lucky Curve #3 nib (broad). Has been filled (perhaps 100 or so years ago, otherwise near mint++.	\$700
9	Parker	1910	Model 47 Eyedropper-fill. One of the most beautiful of the early Parker pens. Nicknamed the "Pregnant Parker" because of the bulbous design of the alternating pearl slabs (which are soaked until soft so they can be so shaped). Wonderful yellow, green and red iridescence of the pearl. Gold-filled high relief repousse floral cap and barrel bands. Indicia engraved in beautiful Script lettering "G.E.B." Medium/fine, extra-flexible nib. Has been filled, perhaps 100 years ago or more. Near mint+.	\$4500
10	Parker	1915	Model 62 BF in Gold-filled etched Floral design. The button-fill version is much rarer than the eyedropper-fill model! Fully covered, including the gripping section and blind cap. Indicia is not engraved. Parker "Lazy S" #2 nib (fine, extra-flexible). Beautiful pen! The smallest ding in the indicia and another around the back within the floral design, otherwise near mint.	\$1,600
11	Waterman	1925	58 LF in Woodgrain Hard Rubber. GFT. Fine nib. Much rarer than the sister 58 Red Ripple or Black. New-old-stock. ABSOLUTELY MINT! You'll never find one nicer!	\$2000
12 13	Waterman	1929	Patrician LF in Nacre (Black & Pearl). GFT. Fine nib. These are most often found with terrible discolor. This set is almost perfect, with perhaps the smallest tinge of ambering of the pencil cap. Otherwise new-old-stock. Mint. Twist-activated pencil for above set.	\$1600
14	Waterman	1927	42 Octagonal Continental Safety eyedropper-fill in Rolled-gold (a.k.a. Gold-filled). Alternating panels of fine Barley and Diamonds formed within Pinstriping. Cal with clip and three massive repousse Putti, separated by repousse floral and vine. Repousse cap top. Fine, extra-flexible nib. A few minor marks on the smooth metal just above the turning knob, otherwise new-old-stock in original box. No signs of use. Unrestored.	\$2250
15	Waterman	1927	0552 Continental LF in 18KR (Gold-filled) overlay. "Checkerboard pattern with alternating squares of Yellow GF "Barley" and White GF "Open Filigree" work. Absolutely beautiful! Repousse rose on cap top. Has the "CD Winged Nib" logo for "Cavalieri" who was Waterman's licensee in Italy. Extra-fine, flexible nib. Tiny dent and half-a-pinhead of brassing on the very bottom of the barrel, otherwise near mint.	\$2200
16	Waterman	1927	0552 Continental LF in 18KR (gold-filled) overlay. Alternating panels of "Barley" and "Vines" on a Pebble background." Extra fine, triple flexible nib. Brassing to the cap band and bottom edge of the barrel bottom, otherwise near mint.	\$1500

17	D.J. Kennedy	1993	<p>Oversize "George Bush Peace Pen" bulb-fill in Sterling Silver "Hammered Vine" pattern. The pen commemorates the fall of the Berlin Wall on November 9 1989. Cap engraved "[Heart] Peace Under One Sky." Barrel engraved with a replica of George Bush's signature and "U.S.1." Artist signed on the insert inside the barrel, "No. 4 Peace Pen. [??] Fall 1989 [??] 15 August 1993 D.J. Kennedy." "[?]" means I can't make out the engraved words. The insert is also engraved "Collection of Bevy Jaegers (and) C.M. Bozorth." Uses an #8 size Moore Monarch nib/feed and section, the section covered in sterling silver. Lapis stone in both the cap top and the barrel bottom. Purple cabochon mounted just above the clip. The pen was sent as a gift to George Bush who declined acceptance and returned it to the maker. A very early (and very rare) D.J.K. pen, famed artist and Sculptor, who also produced pens by private order and for Nieman Marcus. Fine nib.</p> <p>Also included are the matching ink bottle. A repousse swan adorns the bottle cap. A 7/8" D.J. Kennedy made Sterling Silver band surrounds the bottle, with heavy "Vine repousse work. The indicia is engraved "Dr. O's Miracle Ink for Bush Pen 9 February 1994."</p> <p>Still more! Included is the wooden form used by D.J. Kennedy for the rough shaping of the sterling silver cap and barrel. Finally, included is the hand carved form fitted wooden presentation box made by D.J.K. for the pen! The ca. 7" x 3" x 1 3/4" box is "hinged" with a free form piece of distressed rawhide leather.</p> <p>A unique opportunity to own a D. J. Kennedy ensemble, perhaps the only one of it's kind ever to exist! #### Featured - Sheaffer WASP (plus a couple of other sub-brand pens)

During the Depression many companies introduced lower priced models so as to not detract or lower the prices of their existing models. I.e., Parker introduced Thrift Time; Conklin, the All American; Esterbrook, the Dollar Pen; Sheaffer, both WASP and VACUUM-FIL. UNIVER (circa 1930) and CRAIG (circa 1912), other Sheaffer sub-brands, were introduced earlier. CRAIG was Sheaffer's son's name, WASP stands for W.A. Sheaffer Pen, CLIPPER was named after the Pan American Airways China Clipper airplane, UNIVER was likely a shortening of an earlier sub-brand, UNIVERSITY (circa 1912, described as a coin-filler pen). To save money, many nibs were stainless steel, those which are gold (all the nibs below) are 10K rather than 14K.

19	Wasp	1938	THE CLIPPER #7 LF in Green Birdseye (Green Pearl with Black Blotches). GFT. Visualated section. The 10K nib is designed to write face up (fine) or face down (extra-fine), and is factory imprinted "WASP Writes two ways Made in USA." Near Mint.	\$275
20	Wasp	1938	VACUUM-FIL #4 vacuum-fill in Green Birdseye (Green Pearl with Black Blotches). GFT. Medium nib (probably 10K solid gold). Visualated section. New-old-stock. Near mint with original barrel label.	\$175

22	Wasp	1938	VACUUM-FIL #2 size LF in Red & Green Pearl. Black ends. GFT. 10K fine, italic nib. Near mint.	\$150

24	Univer	1929	#4 size LF in Gold Lahn (Black with Gold Ribbon in random multidirectional lines). GPT. 10K nib (medium) is signed "Univer Made in USA). Near mint.	\$125

30	Wasp	1940	THE CLIPPER 394 (#4 size) LF in Grey Pearl (Grey Brickwork with Black Pinstriping). GPT. Black cap top. Visualated section. 10K nib is designed to write face up (fine) or face down (extra-fine), and is factory imprinted "WASP Writes two ways Made in USA." More streamlined shape than the pen above. Nr mint.	\$175
31	Wasp	1940	THE CLIPPER #4 size vacuum-fill in Grey Pearl (description above). NPT with pointed black cap top. Visualated section. 10K fine nib. Shorter length. A touch of cap top edge brassing otherwise near mint.	\$125
32	Wasp	1939	THE CLIPPER DE LUXE #7 size LF in Green Pearl (Green Brickwork with Black Pinstriped Panels). GPT with GF "jewels" on top and bottom. Visualated section. Two-toned 10K nib is designed to write face up (fine) or face down (extra-fine), and is factory imprinted "WASP Writes two ways Made in USA." Nr mint.	\$275
33	Wasp	1938	THE CLIPPER #6 size LF in Green Pearl (description above). GPT with GF "jewels" on cap top and barrel bottom. Visualated section. 10K fine nib. A tad of cap band wear, otherwise near mint.	\$150
34	Wasp	1938	THE CLIPPER #3 size LF in Green Pearl (Green Brickwork with Black Pinstriped Panels). GPT with GF "jewels" on cap top and barrel bottom. Visualated section. 10K medium nib. Near mint+.	\$150
35	Wasp	1940	THE CLIPPER #4 size vacuum-fill in Green Pearl (description above). GFT with cap top tassie. Visualated barrel. 10K medium nib. More streamlined than the pen above. Band edge brassing, otherwise near mint.	\$150

39	Montblanc	1930	4M Safety eyedropper-fill in BHR. Nickel-plate accommodation clip. Cap marked both Montblanc and Stoffhaus, Montblanc's boutique stores of the time. Extra-fine, flexible nib. Near mint.	\$600
40	Montblanc	1936	234 1/2 PL PIF in Platinum (perhaps Montblanc's most beautiful celluloid). GFT. Fine nib. Visualated barrel. Near mint.	\$1750
41	Montblanc	1936	234 1/2 PIF in Black. Visualated barrel window. GFT. Medium nib. Some band brassing, otherwise nr mint.	\$375
42	Montblanc	1940	132 Deluxe PIF in Black with Long Visualated Window with perfect pinstriping. GFT. Inner Cap factory imprinted "MONTBLANC DELUXE." Near mint++, could be new-old-stock.	\$500
43	Montblanc	1941	422 Stylograph Push-knob fill in Black. GFT. Barrel imprint, "Importe d'Allemagne," shows that the pen was made for the French market. The red dot on the inner cap depicts that it is a stylograph. Slightest wear to the barrel imprint (fully readable), otherwise near mint.	\$400
44	Montblanc	1943	334 1/2 PIF in Black. Wartime model with four chased cap bands and an alloy nib (broad) instead of gold. Many users say that it writes better than the gold nibs! Correct NP clip. Near mint.	\$300
45	Montblanc	1946	244 BF in Green Marble. GFT. Broad, flexible, italic nib. Near mint.	\$450
46	Montblanc	1930	003 twist-operated propel-only Pencil in BHR. Knurled turning knob at top. Outline star. Model number not imprinted on the pencil. New-old-stock. Mint.	\$175
47	Montblanc	1934	L3 Pix button-activated repeater pencil in Black. "Luxury" version with fancy band, clip and engraved metal cap top. The pencil is factory engraves "3" but should be "L3." Near mint+	\$350
