When reading item descriptions, please assume each nib is original for its pen, and is 14K gold, unless otherwise noted.



| 1 | Moore | 1900 | No. 2 Safety eyedropper-fill pen in GF repousse "Chased" on BHR. Even the "sliding" portion of the barrel is metal covered. Early "short" cap model. Correct "American Fountain Pen" nib. Rare and gorgeous! 1896 patent date. Indicia engraved "Charles R. Hotaling Albany NY." Charles was the Sergeant-at-Arms of the NY State Senate Assembly in Albany, NY. I found records of his work there as early as 1905 and as late as his 1931 re-appointment. In 1911 he was involved in a US Senate investigation of corrupt Albany politics. Fine, flexible nib. One small dent in the crown, and just a tad of distress to the posting knob on the bottom, otherwise near mint. | \$2500 |
| 2 | Waterman | 1900 | 402 eyedropper-fill straight-holder in Sterling Silver "Chased" (snail) pattern. Indicia engraved in Old English Script: "船船." Crisp and beautiful! Fine, flexible nib. Near mint. | \$2000 |
| 3 | Anonymous | 1900 | #2 eyedropper-fill straight-holder in Black Hard Rubber with Sterling Silver repousse "Chased Filigree" overlay. Unsigned pen with English hallmarks. "Warranted" nib (medium). Near mint. | \$650 |
| 4 | Anonymous | 1905 | #2 eyedropper-fill Taper-cap in Black Hard Rubber. The barrel covered with alternating abalone & pearl overlay. GFT. Unsigned 14K nib with early crescent vent hole (fine, extra-flex) Near mint | \$600 |
| 5 | Montblanc | 1940 | 136 PIF in Black. Rare long window version with vertical lines in excellent condition. GFT. Two-toned, fine nib. Near mint+ | \$950 |
| 6 | Waterman | 1917 | 416 PSF Lever-fill eyedropper-fill in Black Hard Rubber with a Sterling Silver "Filigree" overlay. Incredibly rare. "PSF" stands for "personal self filler." Medium/broad, italic, flexible nib. Near mint condition with crisp imprints and no oxidation. | \$2200 |
| 7 | Parker | 1916 | Model 33 Jack Knife Safety eyedropper-fill in Black Hard Rubber with gold-filled "Chased Filigree" barrel overlay and cap crown. Crisp cap imprint; some wear to the "33" imprint on the bottom of the barrel. Fine, extra-flexible nib. Near mint. | \$500 |
| 8 | Sheaffer | 1917 | #2 LF in Sterling Silver "Night & Day" over Black Hard Rubber. Very rare in gold-filled – extremely rare in sterling silver! Medium/fibe, extra-flexible nib. The hard rubber is oxidized except where protected by the cap, otherwise near mint. The silver has it's 100 year old patina. | \$1750 |







| 20 | Pelikan | 1929 | 1 st Year piston-fill pen, usually called a Model 100, but actually had no model number until 1930. Straight-sided inner cap, no cap bands, Bakelite barrel, long-slender gripping section, and nib with a heart shaped vent hole (fine, flexible). Minor discoloration of the jade binde (usually found darker), otherwise nr mint. | \$1900 |
| 21 | Pelikan | 1931 | 100 PIF in Jade. GFT. Fine, extra-flexible nib. Characteristics include a conical inner cap, 2 cap bands, Bakelite barrel, long-slender gripping section, and nib with a circular shaped vent hole (fine, extra-flexible). Some discoloration of the jade binde (usually found much darker), otherwise near mint. | \$1000 |
| 22 | Pelikan | 1931 | 100 PIF in Honey (very rare). Celluloid barrel). GFT. Medium nib. Near mint+ | \$2000 |
| 23 | Pelikan | 1942 | 100 PIF in Grey Marble (rare). Acrylic barrel. GFT. Smooth turning knob. First Pelikan synthetic plastic piston gasket (black). Right oblique, medium, flexible nib (shaped like left foot). Near mint+ | \$650 |
| 24 | Pelikan | 1942 | 100 PIF in Red Pearl. A very rare binde! Acrylic barrel. GFT. Smooth turning knob. First Pelikan synthetic-plastic piston gasket (black). GFT. Visualated barrel. Medium nib. Near mint. Fine nib. | \$1900 |
| 25 | Pelikan | 1938 | 100N PIF in 14K solid Gold. Alternating wide engine turned, narrow plain and pinstripe panels. Black cap. Orange celluloid barrel. GFT. Medium nib. Near mint+ | \$2800 |
| 26 | Pelikan | 1942 | 100CN PIF in Green Pearl. Rare, manufactured in Pelikan's Danzig plant rather than Hannover. Special characteristics include the single cap band and arrow shaped clip. Broad chromium-nickle nib (used when gold was needed for the war & not allowed for nib manufacture). Correct, black synthetic gasket. Near mint+ | \$450 |
| 27 | Pelikan | 1942 | 101N PIF in Tortoise. GFT. Rare model, the same height as other 100N ands 101Ns, but the cap tube is longer and inner cap shorter! Special models, made for the Swiss market, designed to thwart pickpocketing. Rare and unusual, especially in this rare Celluloid! GFT. Green acrylic barrel. Stub, flexible nib. Near mint. | \$2000 |
| 28 | Pelikan | 1950 | 100N PIF Transitional model, manufactured using a brown striped binde, identical to that used for the Model 400, introduced that year. Very rare! Oblique, double-broad nib (shaped like left foot) New-old-stock. Mint. | \$1900 |
| 29 | Pelikan | 1950 | 450 repeater pencil in "Mother of Pearl" one of the rarest Pelikan Celluloids. GFT. Near mint. | \$575 |
| 30 | Pelikan | 1950 | Pocket Knife in Ivory Veined Celluloid. Rare, either given to employees or an advertising premium. Blades used. One blade has a logo showing a stick drawing of a duck on one side and two words on the other. The first probably the manufactures's name; the second the location, "Solingen," known as "The City of Knives." | \$150 |





| 31 | Conklin | 1924 | The Duragraph was introduced in the second quarter of 1924 in Black Hard Rubber and Red Hard Rubber, both as a crescent-fill and a lever-fill. It came with a lifetime guarantee covering both accident and wear. These were only manufactured for a few months and are very rare today. "Toledo" nibs were used. The senior size men's models were extra long - 5 1/4" closed and 7 ½" with the cap posted. "Medium " and "Short" models, were both designed to be almost 6" long with the cap posted. Duragraph LF in Red Hard Rubber and correct Red Mottled Hard Rubber gripping section. GFT. Fine nib. Near mint. | \$1500 |
| 32 | Conklin | 1924 | Duragraph LF in Black Hard Rubber. GFT. Extra-fine/fine nib. Near mint. | \$1000 |
| 33 | Conklin | 1924 | Duragraph LF in Black Hard Rubber. GFT. Medium/broad, italic nib. Some wear to the imprint (not all readable), otherwise near mint. | \$750 |
| 34 | Conklin | 1924 | Short Duragraph LF in Black Hard Rubber. Non-cataloged model, as Conklin shows it only in a ring-top version, not a version with a clip. Perhaps a prototype! Especially with it's narrow cap band! There is no other hard rubber non-ring-top cap which fits the pen. Medium/fine nib. Some imprint wear (fully readable) otherwise near mint. | \$500 |
| 35 | Conklin | 1924 | In 1924, a few months after introducing the Duragraph, Conklin changed its name to the Endura . The lifetime guarantee remained the same. RHR and BHR were still offered, and the Senior size pens were still extra long. "Toledo" nibs were still used. (Extra) Long Endura in Red Hard Rubber. GFT. Fine nib. Near mint. | \$1250 |
| 36 | Conklin | 1924 | (Extra) Long Endura in Black Hard Rubber. GFT. Medium/fine nib. New-old-stock. Mint. [Three available: (1) Medium/fine nib; (2) Medium nib; (3) without a barrel imprint (not worn off – never had one), otherwise near mint with a very rare medium extra-flexible nib at \$900.] | \$1000 |

Eversharp Kimberly Pockette Vintage Ball Pen

Eversharp was in dire straights with the failure of their "Fifth Avenue" model pen and their ballpoint, the "CA" was unreliable. Along came the Kimberly Company who in 1947 introduced and successfully manufactured a reliable ball pen. Several companies sued Kimberly for patent infringement, including Eversharp. Eversharp acquired an interest (eventually owning the company in 1955) and Kimberly became an exclusive Eversharp brand. It was discontinued in 1957 when Parker acquired Eversharp. The "Pockette" was Kimberly's first ball pen, 3 ½" closed and 5 1/8" open, the same length as the Parker jotter. All the pens below are working and have modern refills. [Buy all 12 at \$300.]
